- Regional in scope

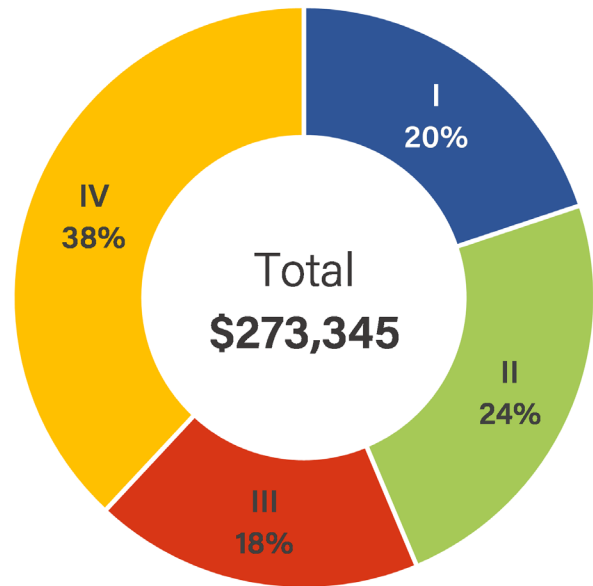
